Policy for the Post Graduate Programs admission from academic year 2022-2023.

- 1. Out of the total seats, 15% will be reserved for Management quota (University Circular No. Spl. Cell/(68)121812005 dated 3rd June, 2005 and 402 of 2022 dated 23rd June, 2022).
- 2. The remaining quota should be filled equally by minority students (50%) and general category (50%) students. If the minority seats remain vacant then those vacant seats can be transferred to the general category on approval of the Principal.
- 3. There will be ONE Christian minority merit list including Wilsonian and non-Wilsonian and for students from other universities. The seats for minorities can be filled according to this merit list. Preference will be given to in-house and University of Mumbai Protestant minority.
- 4. There will be TWO merit lists for General category students, one for Mumbai University students and another for Students from other than Mumbai University or from states other than Maharashtra .5% (of the total seats) will be reserved for students Other than Mumbai University. This is not applicable to the program where the total number of seats is less than 10, 50% seats can be given to in-house students on merit. If students count in the Minority quota from other universities is filled then this 5% rule is not applicable.
- 5. Students from other than Mumbai University should submit a provisional eligibility certificate obtained from Mumbai University during the admission. It is binding on the students to submit the Eligibility certificate within a few weeks of admission, failing which the admission is liable to be cancelled.
