Admission Notice for M.Sc./M.A./M.Com. Part-I / B.Sc. (Honors) 4th year 2026-2027 (Under NEP-2020)

- Online admission forms for Postgraduate (P.G. Part-I) / B.Sc. (Honors) 4th year courses at **Wilson College** will be available at www.wilsoncollege.edu from **12th May 2026 to 28th May 2026**.
- The last date for filling the online admission form is **28th May 2026 up to 5.00 p.m.**
- Admission will be granted on the basis of marks obtained in Semester V and Semester VI of the Third-Year examination (**excluding Applied Component marks**), wherever applicable.
- It is mandatory for students to complete the **University pre-registration / pre-enrolment process as well as the college application form for confirmation of admission.**
- Students must first create their registration account, after which a login ID will be generated. Using this login, students must complete their profile by filling in personal details such as name, address, **ABC ID, educational qualifications, reservation category, photograph, signature, and contact number.**
- For admission to postgraduate courses, students must register the *programme/course* they wish to apply for during the pre-admission registration process.
- An **ABC ID** is compulsory for registration. Students who do not have an ABC ID should create one through the official portal: www.abc.gov.in
- The **University pre-registration / pre-enrolment** process can be completed through the Mumbai University admission portal: <https://muadmission.samarth.edu.in>
- *It is **MANDATORY** to fill only the Semester V and Semester VI (if available) total marks of the main subject only. (Exclude Applied Component Marks), wherever applicable.*
- Students who have passed Semester VI but are awaiting their marksheet may also apply; however, their admission will remain provisional until submission of the marksheet.
- Students are also required to enter the CGPA of Semester I, II, III, and IV in the admission form.
- Students from other Universities should submit an undertaking at the time of admission regarding compliance of eligibility criteria as laid down by the University of Mumbai. The prescribed undertaking form is given in Annexure-1 hereunder. (The application for provisional statement of eligibility along with the supporting documents are to be submitted in the college office without which the admission will not be confirmed).
- Admissions will be granted strictly on the basis of merit and according to the rules and norms laid down by the University of Mumbai and the State Government, as applicable to minority institutions.
- Admission will be confirmed only after verification of documents by the college authorities and payment of the prescribed fees by the student.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

- Visit the website www.wilsoncollege.edu Check “Admission for PG Part- I / B.Sc. (Honors) 4th year”.
- Enter all the details carefully and correctly in the application form.
- Upload the following documents:
 1. Copy of the marksheets of semesters I, II, III, IV, V & VI. In case copies of marks sheet for semester VI is not received then kindly submit the picture of the relevant page of the consolidated mark list given by the University, with your name, seat number and scores highlighted in pdf format.
 2. Baptism certificate for Christian minority students.
 3. Supporting documents for students claiming admission under Reserved/Special Category.
 4. Email ID and mobile number recorded in the online admission form will be treated as final for exchanging all communication.
 5. Proof of residential address i.e. Aadhar card (both sides compulsory).
 6. Submit your duly filled application form online only.
 7. Eligible candidates for admission to M.Sc. / M.A./ M.Com./ B.Sc. (Honors) 4th year programme will receive a link for the payment of fees by SMS/ mail.
 8. After your name appears in the merit list, you are required to get the hard copies of all the documents uploaded by you to the college office for final verification, after which payment of fees will have to be done for confirming the admission.
